The ice and snow event went well. Our crew worked before the event to acquire needed supplies of salt and sand and to have them stockpiled. We had plows on the ton trucks and had the spreaders attached and ready to roll before the storm hit.

We built a building at the yard to store supplies of sand and salt and cold mix. The bottom and sides are concrete and the building is tall enough for dump trucks to dump supplies. The building was finished just in time for the storm to hit. We had ample room for supplies and were able to protect them like needed.

We are working toward completing the projects bumped from 2020 when we received funding for the grant projects.

We are working to acquire more grant funding for this year.
