Next: AGENDA: Motion made by J.P. Holt to amend the agenda and entertain one additional resolution, 2nd by J.P. Philips. Motion was approved.

Next: MINUTES: J.P. Philip made a motion to approve the minutes of March 18th, 2021 as printed, 2nd by J.P. Lemings, Judge James asks for any discussion. There was none. Minutes were approved unanimously.

- Next: TREASURE REPORT: J.P. Holt made a motion to approve the treasure's report as printed, seconded by J.P. N. Brown. Judge James asked for any discussion. There was none, the treasure report was approved unanimously.
