AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS OF THE PERSONNEL POLICY;

WHEREAS: The Personnel Policy was updated by Ordinance 2021-14; and

WHEREAS: sections of the Policy will need to be clarified according to AAC; and

WHEREAS: These changes will take affect upon passage of this Ordinance.

WHEREAS: Page 22-Section B, HOLIDAY LEAVE: The County will be closed to observe all legal Holidays listed below. All full-time County Employees will be granted paid leave on these days at 8 hours, in exception of the County Road Department. The County Road Department will be granted paid leave at a 10 hour day, unless their hours are changed to 8 hour days.

Any Full-time employee who works on a paid Holiday will receive Holiday hours in addition to their hours worked. If the Employee has worked 80 hours during the payroll, the hours worked on the Holiday will be rolled over into the employee's comp-time, with exception of the Sheriff office Deputies and Detention Center employees. Due to the schedules of the Detention Center and the Sheriff's Deputies, these employees will receive pay for the Holiday.

- (2) Martin Luther King Birthday-January 19
 (3) President's Day-3rd Monday in February
- (4) Good Friday-Friday before Easter
- (5) Memorial Day-Last Monday in May
- (6) Independence Day-July 4

- (8) Veteran's Day-November 11
- (9) Thanksgiving Day-4th Thursday in November
- (10)Black Friday-The Friday after Thanksgiving

Additional Holidays may be proclaimed by the County Judge.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF VAN BUREN, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO BE CALLED THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN FUND; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

Article 1. <u>Affirmation.</u> It comes before this Court that there is a need to establish a special revenue fund on the books of the County to track revenues, expenditures and/or appropriated transfers of Federal assistance through the American Rescue Plan Act. This Court recognizes and affirms the need for such fund to properly account for and control all such revenues received and expenditures made in compliance with all applicable laws and guidance from the U.S. Treasury.

Article 2. <u>Establishment of Fund</u>. There is hereby created on the books of the Van Buren County Treasurer and the books of the Van Buren County Clerk a special revenue fund to be known as the American Rescue Plan Fund with a fund number of 3046 as assigned by Arkansas Legislative Audit. The revenue code for the Federal assistance through the ARP Act, as assigned by Legislative Audit, is 7112 – Federal Coronavirus Relief.

Article 3. Operation of Fund. The American Rescue Plan Fund is subject to all the normal County budgeting, appropriation and expenditure regulations of Arkansas Code Annotated, Title 14 and the County Financial Management System implemented in accordance with §14-21-101. Funds must be used only in accordance with guidelines issued by the U.S. Treasury concerning the legal expenditures of revenues received pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (P.L. 11-2), which established the Federal Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund. Proper records and documentation must be maintained for Federal audit purposes.

Article 4. Emergency Clause. It is found by this Court that the deposit of Federal assistance funds from the American Rescue Plan Act are imminent making it necessary to establish the American Rescue Plan Fund in order to be able to properly track the revenue, appropriated expenditures and/or appropriated transfers. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this order to be in full force and effect from the date of passage and approval.
