## County Roads and Equipment Report September, 2019

The County Road Department has completed work on the Dean Road Bridge to put a permanent fix on an area of chronic washouts.

Work is in progress on Old Highway 9 which is a 50/50 mitigation grant project. Upon completion of the Old Highway 9 project, work will begin on Buttercreek to replace the bridge. We have all the materials on hand to complete that project fairly quickly. The Shirley Bridge will follow Buttercreek.

Culverts and drainage projects scheduled include:

Rumley Road

Watson Road

Foster Cemetery Road

Buttercreek (in addition to the bridge)

Wilderness Trail (Hwy. 389)

Gravesville Cutoff (2)

Klondike Road

The striping project has been completed.

We are close to completing the routes with ditches being pulled. The grader operators are doing an excellent job of ditching and reclaiming gravels from the ditches back to the roads.
